

Power requirements: 9v 500mA DC adaptor
1 x PP3 9V Alkaline, 4 x AAA Alkaline batteries

CAUTION: RISK OF EXPLOSION IF BATTERY IS REPLACED BY AN INCORRECT TYPE. DISPOSE OF USED BATTERIES ACCORDING TO THE INSTRUCTIONS.

Use only the power adaptor supplied.

Do not overload power outlets and extension cords. This can result in fire or electric shock.

Completely insert the power adaptor into the power outlet. Failure to do so may result in electric shock and/or excessive heat causing a fire.

Regularly remove any dust etc. from the power adaptor by pulling from the power outlet and wiping with a soft dry cloth. Accumulated dust may cause an insulation defect.

Unplug the product from power outlets if it emits smoke, an abnormal smell or makes an unusual noise.

Unplug from power outlets and never touch the inside of the product if the case is broken.

Never touch the plug with wet hands – danger of electric shock exists.

Operating Safeguards

Unplug the product from the power outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners.

Do not disassemble the product.

Do not spill liquids (e.g. detergents, cleaners) onto the product or telephone line cord plug, or allow them to become wet. This may cause a fire. If the telephone cord plug becomes wet, immediately pull it from the telephone wall jack and do not use.

Installation

Never install telephone wiring during lightning.

Never install telephone line jacks in wet locations unless the jack is specifically designed for wet locations.

Never touch uninsulated telephone wires or terminals unless the telephone line has been disconnected at the network interface.

Batteries

Do not mix old and new batteries.

Disconnect the phone line and unplug power before replacing the batteries.

Do not open the batteries or dispose of in a fire.
